- Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- Refreshments are usually available from a small tuck shop adjacent to the pitch you are watching.
- If you are able to, we greatly appreciate your contribution to any fundraising activities such as raffles.
- Dogs are not permitted at these grounds.
- Please take away your litter.
- Have fun - it's what we are all here for!

## Navigation

Castle Dyke Playing Field isn't the easiest place to find, so we hope the maps below help. Driving from Bents Green on Ringinglow Road towards the countryside, you will pass Common Lane on your right. There is a bus stop on the left-hand side and some 50 yards later a 50 MPH road sign, also on your left. After a further 50 yards you need to turn left down a Bridle Path; at the entrance of this lane is a sign to Birkdale Sports Ground. Proceed down this lane slowly and at the end you will drive through the gates into the sports ground car park. The pitches are through another gate where you will need to walk from the car park. The sports pavilion will be on your left as you enter the grass pitches.



## Parking

Please park your vehicles respectfully when visiting our venue, in the **blue** zones below. Do not block any access or egress points.

## Toilets

Toilets are available at the grounds inside the sports pavilion. This is indicated by the **green** zone on the map below.



## Pitch Locations

Please see the above plan of pitch locations. If there is already a game ongoing, please spectate behind the Respect barrier until the game is complete and the pitch is available to use for a warm-up.

## Defibrillator

A defibrillator (AED) is located inside the sports pavilion first aid room. This is indicated by the **red** zone on the above map. Should Cardiac Arrest occur, begin CPR immediately, and call 999 whilst sending someone else to collect the AED.
