The works to improve the drainage of our pitches at Redmires have been successful - ironic, I know, that we've undertaken the work preparing for the wettest weather winter can throw at us at Lodge Moor when rainfall has been almost absent and the ground is rock hard! So hard, in fact, that final works have been delayed to the lower of the 11-a-side pitch. That pitch is available as is the 9v9 pitch but works will recommence just as soon as we get some rain.

The top pitch at Redmires is not available for use until at least w/c 22nd August and the Steering Committee will confirm when it's available. The lack of rain has meant the seeding has not yet worked and having invested considerable sums into this we need to protect our investment. I realise this will cause some pre-season fixtures to be cancelled or moved to an away fixture but this is in the best long term interests of the club.

We're very keen to attract more volunteers to help us - I'd love to hear from parents interested in getting more involved because the club needs you. In particular, **we're looking for people to help our two welfare officers, Andy and Sarah**. As numbers of players and teams increase we're in need of some extra pairs of hands to help out. We have lots of roles - social media and fund-raising too - if you're interested, drop me a line.

Finally, the **AGM is to be rescheduled in September - I will confirm the date in the next 2 weeks**. We'd love to see you there where we'll be sharing updates and an end of season report. It's your opportunity to get involved and I hope to see you there.
