

Thank you to the 45 girls who completed the players' survey – a fantastic response rate of 58%, well in excess of the FA's target of 25%. Congratulations to the Girls U12s Greens, who were the winning team in terms of responses.

Thanks to the input of so many of our girls, the survey was a really worthwhile and insightful exercise for the club. We are hoping to conduct a similar survey with the boys' teams in coming months.

The survey showed that the girls have very positive views about the club, their teams and their coaches. It served as an excellent reminder to all managers and coaches as to why the girls play football and what they look for in a coach. It also highlighted the potential interest of many of the girls in volunteering at the club in future in order to inspire younger players, for example by coaching and / or refereeing. This is something we will try to facilitate.
