New Club-wide Shirt Sponsorship Deal

At the end of another successful season, the club is delighted to announce a 5 year sponsorship deal with Sheffield-based production company, <u>VeryMuchSo</u> from the start of the 22/23 season.

I am delighted the club has secured this longterm, club-wide sponsorship deal. It will enable the club to invest with confidence in its pitches and to continue to grow the number of teams across the club.

Daniel Gordon, owner of VeryMuchSo, said: "We feel honoured and proud to sponsor Hallam and Redmires Rangers. As a company local to Redmires, we have been sponsoring the Girls teams for the past five seasons, and seen the growth here from one team to hopefully nine next season. This club-wide sponsorship shows our commitment to grassroots football and we hope this can give the club stability and enable it to continue to attract more kids to play and, most importantly, to enjoy their football."

The deal, worth £5,000 per season for an initial 3 years, with the option of 2 more years, will see the VeryMuchSo logo on all playing shirts. Opportunities for sponsorship for other items are still there and we'll be honouring any existing arrangements that are in place.

It's the end of another successful season for Hallam and Redmires Rangers – we've successfully navigated more fixtures than ever before with the growth of the club. New kit for 22/23

From next season all Hallam and Redmires Teams will transition to a new Macron green and white hooped shirt, green skins top, green shorts and green socks and by the start of 23/24 we anticipate all teams will be wearing the same kit as they go through their 2 year kit cycle. In addition to the traditional green and white hoops, all players will be provided with a grey Macron away kit/training kit (shirt, shorts and socks) and all coaches will be provided with a consistent set of kit too. A big thank you to Matt Coulson and Russ Leighton for the hard work they've put in behind the scenes to get this all sorted. Your respective managers will be asking you to fill out kit requirements in due course.

Investing in Our Pitches at Redmires

Redmires is the home of Hallam and Redmires Rangers but we know drainage and the playing surfaces overall aren't great. That's why the club steering committee has approved a significant investment of around £27k to improve the pitches this summer. We will continue to make improvements to the 'car park pitch' following on from last summer's drainage work and we will commence work on both the 'top pitch' and the 9 v 9 pitch. We expect the works to reduce the likelihood of cancellations by improving the drainage and the overall surface. We know this is going to be an ongoing process and we're looking at ways in which we can access grant funding for the future.

Works will commence on Monday 20 June 2022 and we anticipate that the car park pitch and 9x9 will be out of action for two weeks. The top pitch will be unusable for 6 weeks minimum.
